

Preparing a Poster

It is part of the School policy for our postgraduate research students that:

Postgraduate students will be required to complete a poster by the time of their second year annual review of progress. The poster may be aimed at either

- (a) a professional conference or
- (b) first or second year mathematics students.

The School will provide advice on poster preparation and cover the costs. There will be an annual poster judging and a \$150 book voucher and certificate for the best poster.

The documents contained in this folder are intended to provide the advice mentioned above, and should enable you to format a poster of size A0. These documents have been provided by Alys Clarke, and an example of her poster has been included for you to view.

The actual **content** of your poster should be discussed with your supervisor. The **size** of your poster should be either A1 or A0.

The School will cover the cost of printing your poster, by an approved printer. Please obtain a quote first, for printing and laminating, and get this approved by the Postgraduate Coordinator before proceeding.
